

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR THE SUPPLY OF TYRES/TUBES/FLAPS FOR CHANDIGARH POLICE

1. The different sizes of tyres/tubes/flaps are enclosed.
2. The tender addressed to Inspector General of Police, UT sector-9 Chandigarh should be sent in a sealed cover marked in bold letter (TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY OF TYRES/TUBES/FLAPS FOR CHANDIGARH POLICE." No tender will be accepted without earnest money and received after 11.00 AM on 14.07.2011.
3. The firm should not have been declared "Black listed" by any Govt/Semi Govt. Department and in this respect an affidavit is to be given by the firm.
4. The tender received by the specific date & time shall be opened in the presence of such tenders who may desire to be present at 12.00 Noon on 14.07.2011 in the office of the Inspector General of Police, UT sector-9 Chandigarh.
5. The rate should be quotes F.O.R destination, included all taxes, if any.
6. The supply should be completed within 3-4 weeks from the date of supply order and rates quoted should be valid for three months.
7. The payment will be made only when the entire supply is received and found fit for use as per approved specifications/sizes.
8. In case of firm with whom the supply order is places fails to supply the material according to approved specification/sample within the stipulated period, the earnest money will be forfeited as a penalty.
9. Tenders received late or not conforming to terms and conditions will be rejected.
10. The tender can be accepted/rejected by the competent authority without assigning any reason. The quantity of the tyres/tubes/flaps can be increased/decreased at the time of placing supply order.
11. No Conditional/Telegraphic or Faxes tender will be accepted.

NOTE:-

1. Tenders are required to keep their offers valid for a period of 90 days.
2. The stores will be delivered to the following address for the inspection and acceptance:-

3. All related users manuals, packing cases, containers packing and other similar materials shall be supplied free of cost by the firm and shall not be returned unless otherwise specifically agreed upon.
4. In case the tenders wish to furnish in a separate covering memo for any additional information/particulars of quotation conditions e.g those relating to taxes/duties or allowance of discounts, rebates etc. which can not be accommodates in tender form, they may do so by means of a note attached with tender form.
5. Earnest Money Deposit:- The prospective Suppliers/Vendors will furnish EMD amounting to Rs 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) along with Technical Bids through DD/Postal Order in favour of the Inspector General of Police, UT, Chandigarh. The Firms registered with DGS&D & NSIC are exempted from furnishing of EMD Laws Governing the Contract.
6. Laws of India in force shall govern this contract for the time being.

7. The branch name and specification of tyre/Tube must be clearly mentioned for which rates are quoted.
8. The tender will submit the proof of O.E Manufacturer of Tyres.
9. The Tyres/Tubes should be latest manufacture conforming to the current production standard having 100 % defined life at the time of deliver, Warranty should be minimum 18 months from the date of supply or complete minimum 24000 Kms run whichever earlier against defects, which are attributed to defective material/design or faulty workmanship.
10. The Tyres/tubes should be of the manufacture and not be order those 3 months of the date of acceptance of store by Chandigarh Police.
11. All the tyres and tubes supplied by the firm should be as per the required specification. Sub-standard tyres and tubes will not be accepted.
12. The purchase committee reserves the right to relax any term and condition in the Government interest with the approval of competent authority.
13. No advance payment will be made. The payment will be made after receipt of final bill in triplicate.
14. The purchase committee reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason.
15. Bidders are advised to study the tender documents, terms & Conditions carefully. Submission of tender shall be deemed to have been done so after careful study & examination of tender documents.
16. Jurisdiction of courts. The courts of the place from where the acceptance of tender has been issued shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of the contract.
